



Our **Little Cubs Nursery** is for infants from 6 weeks through 14 months and shares a classroom with our toddlers. The two groups are separated by a low fence. We limit the nursery to eight infants and have four Nursery staff providing excellent care.

We specialize in tender, loving care and we adhere to each child's individual schedule. We teach infant sign language so they can begin to communicate their needs to us. Besides eating and napping, we spend lots of time playing, cuddling, crawling and watching the excitement across the fence.



The Nursery consists of a large play area and a private napping room with eight cribs. We provide bedding, blankets, bibs and all toys. There are exersaucers, swings, bouncy seats, bumbo seats and feeding chairs for the children to use as well as plenty of developmental toys.

We send each child home with a daily report detailing feedings, naps and diaper changes. Our Nursery staff are happy to provide an individual report on how your child's day went when you come to pick them up.

Infants are in the nursery until they are able to eat finger foods independently and walk unassisted, which usually occurs between 12 and 14 months. Then they "hop" over to the toddler area and begin their early preschool education.

What you'll need to bring:

A feeding schedule of when and how much is to be fed ~ An insulated bag with an ice pack to keep prepared bottles chilled ~ Prepared bottles and all foods to be fed throughout the day ~ A spare pacifier that we can keep at our center ~ A change of clothing including an undershirt and socks ~ Diapers, wipes, ointments and any necessary medications.

All of these items should be marked with your child's name.
