



Building Blocks Kindergarten 2016-17

We have an excellent kindergarten program that is taught by an experienced teacher and builds on the skills taught in our Polar Bear Pre-Kindergarten classes.

The curriculum consists of the McGraw Hill “Treasures” Reading and “Math Connects” programs and the classroom is furnished with school desks. Our smaller class size and comprehensive curriculum fully prepares our students for a smooth transition into first grade. Unlike public schools we are able to start where Pre-K ends instead of reviewing all of the basics in order to get all of the students on the same page. The smaller class size also provides the students with individualized attention when needed. We often hear back that our graduates place at the top of their class.

Our math program includes sequencing, patterns, skip counting, addition, subtraction, time and money. Other subject areas covered include Language and Literacy, Science, Social Studies, Art and Computer Lab. There are also plenty of outdoor recreation times and fun activities included to keep everyone happy and busy.



Kindergarten hours are 8:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m.; tuition is \$155 per week. Morning drop off is from 7:00 a.m. on for those needing early care and there is an after care program that runs until 6:00 p.m. for an additional \$5 per day. The registration fee is \$50 and workbooks/classroom materials are included at no extra charge.

Report cards are issued in January, March and June and a cap and gown graduation ceremony is scheduled in mid-June. Children enrolled in the Kindergarten program have an additional week of tuition free vacation time during the winter and spring holidays if you elect to keep them home.
